

Dwight Lamb, Jensen & Bugge

News from the states:

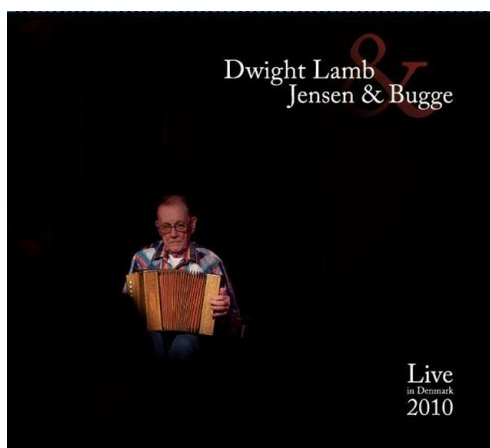
The duo Jensen & Bugge has just returned from a successful U.S. tour. They played no less than 14 concerts featuring accordion player Dwight Lamb of Onawa, Iowa. In addition, the duo played four concerts alone, based on the repertoire of the duo's new anniversary CD, "*Sea and Land - 10 years with Danish traditional music.*"

Dwight's grandfather, Chris Jerup, emigrated from Vendsyssel in the the north of Denmark to Iowa in 1893. He was the son of the legendary musician Kræn Jerup and himself played both fiddle and diatonic accordion. So he brought a large repertoire of Danish folk music with him to the states. When Chris sold his farm and retired, he moved in with the then 12-year-old Dwight and his parents. That gave Dwight the opportunity to learn his grandfathers Danish repertory.

As 19-year-old Dwight also began playing the violin, "over the top", ie. with left hand but without changing the strings around. (It was not a possibility to change the strings around, because he played on his father's violin). For years, he has been great musician with the American old-time music as a specialty. He has taught and inspired a lot of young musicians, many of them did not know that he also plays single-rowed, diatonic accordion!

But fortunately, he recorded a couple of Danish harmonica pieces on a some of his fiddle CDs. Those CDs eventually ended up in Denmark. And thats where Kristian Bugge and Mette Kathrine Jensen first heard of Dwight. And three years ago they managed to arrange a meeting the thre of them at a festival in Minnesota. Since then they have played together many times and in May 2010, Dwight came to Denmark for the first time, on tour as a trio with Jensen & Bugge. Part of the concerts from that tour, was recorded by sound engineer Torben Sminge and prepared for publication.

Just in time for the recently completed tour, the new CD "*Dwight Lamb, Jensen & Bugge Live in Denmark 2010*" was released in the U.S. by Missouri Valley Music, 511 South Pleasant, Canton, South Dakota 57013 (missourivalleymusic@sio.midco.net)! And right now it's beeing printed in DK to come out there as well, on **Tuesday June 21st** at www.gofolk.dk !!!



Dwight Lamb will be back in Denmark in August to play several concerts together with Jensen & Bugge, including the **Tønder Festival** (www.tf.dk) **Hørdum Gl. Skole** and the **Højby Stævne** (www.hoejbystaevne.dk).
